The dog suffers from this and begins to remember his past life with his previous master, a boy named Aukaman.

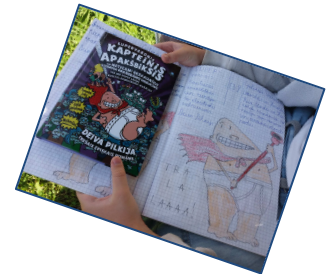
This is one of my favorite books because it tells about friendship between a dog and a boy. They are separated but hope to meet again.
