Peter Pan is a cheerful and boastful boy who comes from a mystical island called “Neverland”. He can fly and never grows up.





Here, among mummies, sarcophaguses and hieroglyphics, I will discover the secret of a scientist who has built a mysterious pyramid of cheese colour!


It is a comic, fascinating, ingenious and easy-to-read book, which I enjoyed very much.
