



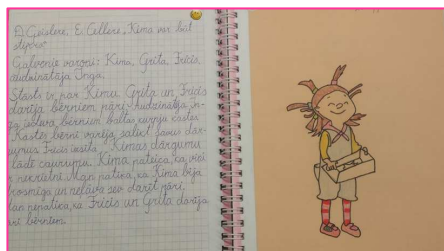
## “Pippi Longstocking” /Astrid Lindgren/
