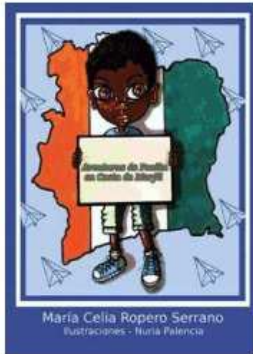




## "Paulin's Adventures in Evry Cost" /Celia Ropero/
