This story tells of Loredana who has only one thought in the world, that is to receive the Smartissimo (a latest generation smartphone).

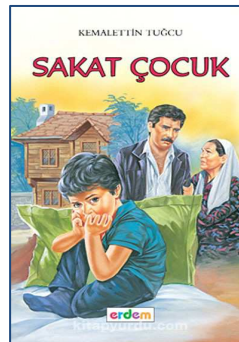


After receiving it from her parents, she discovers that there is a genius in this phone that proposes her to
