Book on stage

<u>Aims and objectives:</u> Improving pupils' motivation to enjoy books.

Activity 1 Find out your own character

Group and Individual Activity/ Age Group: 7-11 years old <u>Time</u>: 08.00 hours

Rules: 1) The teacher helps the child to choose the most appealing character and book

2)The students make their performance on the stage

NB: The reading session can be repeated more than once a time: one can be organized only with young readers in order to practise being on stage, the second one can be organized like a public event with all students' families, etc. In this last case, it is warmly suggested, to organize the public event in an evening atmosphere according to special permissions of local bodies to use public spaces.

Students like to perform in front of an audience, it's a "must-be" condition already present in their mind due to the conditionings of the medias. If they know that , at the end of their study-path, they can have an appointment with a public performance this increases their motivation to read aloud well.

Setting: public space (local theatre, museum hall, public library, a castle, etc.)

Materials required: audio devices: microphone and speakers, spot light on the stage
