Activity 1

Form a sentence!

/Individual Activity/

Age Group: 7-11 years old

Aims: to create interest in the reading process and to develop skills of forming sentences.

Rules: The student forms the sentence by finding the appropriate sentence parts and reads out the sentence. The teacher checks whether the exercise is being completed correctly and the student understands what he/she has read.

Materials required: the sentence cards (contours of each sentence's cards are of the same colour).

A Sample:

A dog has	a beard.	A sheep has

Activity 2

Form sentences!

/Individual Activity/

Age Group: 7-11 years old

Aims: to create interest in the reading process; to read sentences and understand the read information.

Rules: - If the student has reading difficulties, various colours and forms of the cards containing the beginning and the end of the sentence will facilitate the task. The student reads the beginning of the sentence (the card having the orange contour) and then reads the other part of the sentence (the card having the green contour) till the correct statement is found.

The student connects both parts of the sentence, reads the sentence and decides whether the statement is correct. The teacher follows the student's reading comprehension and helps to decide which of the read statements are correct.

Materials required: colourful sentence cards. The orange card contains the beginning of the sentence; the green card contains the end of the sentence.
