



WORKSHEET 3

Alliteration Games

Aims and objectives: Improving of pupils' knowledge about alliteration; skills to work with sounds.

Activity 1

Same Sound

/Individual Activity/


Age Group: 8-11 years old

Rules: The teacher gives to each student a work sheet, like the one in the template, and gives the following instructions:

1. You have to put in order the letters from the first box and to form the name of the object on the picture.
2. Write this word in the second box.
3. Then write down as many words as possible so they start with the same sound as the word in the second box. (The task could require the words to match by their last sound; or by a consonants' combination.)

Materials required: Work sheets (like the one on the sample below).

Activity 2

Think and Write

/Pair Activity/

Age Group: 6-11 years old

Rules:

1. The teacher divides the class into pairs and provide each pair with a set of “sound cards” (on each card is written one sound)
2. Each student has a sheet of paper and a pen.
3. Student A takes one of the cards from the set without looking at them (e.g. sound [t])
4. Student B has 1 (one) minute to write down as many alliterative words with the chosen sound as he can.
5. Then Student B takes one of the cards from the set without looking at them and Student A has 1 (one) minute to write down as many alliterative words with the chosen sound as he can.
6. For each correctly written word the respective student gains one point. The winner is the student who has collected more points.

Materials required: Set of sound-card; blank sheets of paper, pens.

Activity 3

Say in Circle

/Group Activity/

Age Group: 6-11 years old

Rules:

1. All the students stay in a circle.
2. In the middle of the circle there is a small table with a set of cards on it. On each card is written of the letters of the alphabet. Cards are placed on the table upside down.
3. One of the students reveals the first card and shows it to everybody.
4. Going clockwise students one by one have to say a word starting from the revealed letter.
5. When it comes to a student who can not say a word with the revealed letter, or makes a mistake, he/she drops out of the game.
6. The next student in a row has to reveal the next letter, and the game goes on.
7. The winner is the student who is the last to stay in the game.

Materials required: Set of cards with letters (at least one card for each letter)

Activity 4

Find and Match /Teacher - Student Activity/

Age Group: 6-11 years old

Rules:

1. There is a set of picture cards. And some word cards.
2. The Teacher choose one of the word cards in random.
3. The Student has to find among the picture cards those who represent words that are alliterative with the one on the chosen word card. (see the template)
4. Then the Student choose another word card, and the game goes on.
5. The teacher decides how many word cards to use in the game depending on the students age and skills.

Materials required: A set of word cards; a set of picture cards (picture cards should be at least three times more than the word cards).
