Activity 1

What sentence is hidden there?!

/Individual Activity/

Age Group: 7-11 years old

Aims: to read the sentence where all words are written together; to improve visual perception; to repeat the rules of the sentence formation.

Rules: The student reads the line of words and tries to find out what sentence is written there. After reading the given sentence, the student must write it down.

The teacher checks whether the task has been completed correctly and the student has the understanding of what he/she has read.

Materials required: the worksheet.

Activity 2

Read and find proper nouns! /Individual Activity/

Age Group: 7-11 years old

Aims: to read carefully in order to complete the given instructions.

Rules: There are common nouns and proper nouns given below. The child reads them out, underlines words that must be written with the big capital letter, and corrects the mistakes.

The teacher checks whether the student has completed the exercise correctly.

Materials required: word cards and a colorful pencil or a marker for correction of the mistakes.

Activity 3

Assess according to the size! /Individual Activity/ Age Group: 7-11 years old

Aims: to read words and clarify their meaning; to repeat what water bodies the student knows.

Rules: The student reads out the words and clarifies or draws the meaning of each word. The number justifying the size must be written in the circle. Numbering must start with the smallest water body.

The teacher checks whether the student has numbered the given water bodies correctly as well as his/her knowledge of the natural sciences.

Materials required: word cards, colorful pencils or crayons, and stationery.
